

# Screenock's first TV ad says he's passionate about the constitution, rule of law, tuba

Supreme Court candidate Michael Screenock's first TV ad of the Supreme Court campaign says he's passionate about the constitution, the rule of law and the tuba.

The spot shows a picture of Screenock playing the tuba in the UW-Madison marching band. The Sauk County judge then introduces himself, saying he's proud to be backed by a majority of Wisconsin sheriffs "because they know we need a justice who respects our laws, not one marching to their own tune rewriting them."

"If you like the sound of a justice standing for our laws, I'd be honored to earn your vote April 3," he says before playing a few notes on a tuba to close the spot.

The spot will air through Election Day April 3.
