Brookfield, Wis. — State Sen. Leah Vukmir, R-Brookfield, issued the following statement Friday following the announcement that Milwaukee Tool Company plans to build a \$32 million Research and Development facility in Brookfield – a project expected to create 350 new jobs:

“Today’s announcement is fantastic news for Wisconsin with 350 new good-paying jobs on the way for our hard-working working families.

“Just two years ago, Milwaukee Tool expanded its site and created 600 new jobs — proof that our policies are breeding success and creating a strong business climate in Wisconsin.
