

# Rep. Hintz: More to lose health care under Gov. Walker

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## *Actions Speak Louder than Words*

MADISON - Today, the Trump Administration approved Wisconsin's 1115 Medicaid demonstration waiver. In its waiver proposal, the Walker Administration initially projected that enrollment in the program would go down by 5,102. Assembly Democratic Leader Gordon Hintz (D-Oshkosh) released the following statement:

"Actions speak louder than words. On the campaign trail, candidate Scott Walker says he supports coverage for pre-existing conditions and lower premiums.
