**Washington DC** - Wisconsin Congressman Sean Duffy, Chairman of the Financial Services Subcommittee on Housing & Insurance, today voiced his support of local schools applying for Wisconsin's School Safety Grant Initiative. Attorney General Brad Schimel announced the opening of Wisconsin's \$100 million School Safety Grant Initiative. K-12 schools, both public and private, are encouraged to apply for the grants, which will be awarded starting in June.
