WASHINGTON – U.S. Senator Ron Johnson (R-Wis.) said the following after President Trump indicated he may be open to having the United States rejoin the Trans-Pacific Partnership:

Joining the TPP would increase our leverage over China and give U.S. manufactured and agricultural products open access to a trading bloc equaling about 40 percent of world markets.
