WASHINGTON – U.S. Sen. Ron Johnson (R-Wis.), chairman of the Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee, sent a letter to Acting White House Counsel Emmet Flood on Tuesday requesting a briefing on Ivanka Trump's use of private email to conduct official government business.
