## *Vipond Challenges Sensenbrenner in Republican Primary in August*

BROOKFIELD, WIS. – This year's congressional race welcomes a new Republican candidate, Dr. Jennifer Hoppe Vipond. The long-time pediatrician hopes to bring a prescription for change in her run challenging Sensenbrenner, with focus on healthcare policy, the opioid epidemic, and workforce development.

Vipond is challenging Sensenbrenner, who has held the office since 1979. "I respect his fiscal conservatism but there are important issues facing our communities that are not being addressed. As a pediatrician I have intimate knowledge of these challenges."
