Winless Walker Strikes Out

Today, a third judge told Governor Scott Walker that he has to hold elections to fill vacant state legislative seats in Wisconsin. He had previously been refusing to hold elections out of a fear that Democrats would win.

“Scott Walker has been doing everything he can to avoid Wisconsin voters, even breaking the law,” said DGA Press Secretary Melissa Miller. **“He’s right to be scared of Wisconsin voters, though, because they’ve had enough of Governor Walker’s political games that put partisan interests ahead of middle class families.”**
