“After opening a glitzy \$8 million abortion facility in Milwaukee last year, Planned Parenthood is expanding their abortion business again, this time in Sheboygan,” stated Heather Weininger, Executive Director of Wisconsin Right to Life.

Today, Planned Parenthood of Wisconsin announced that they are opening a new clinic in Sheboygan that will offer chemical abortions up to 10 weeks. This comes on the heels of their announcement that they are suing the federal government for the changes made to the Title X program that expands eligibility to health care providers that do not perform abortions.
