The Democratic Party of Wisconsin released the following statement in response to Scott Walker's [new TV ads](#) on the Foxconn deal, attributable to **TJ Helmstetter, DPW spokesperson for the 2018 gubernatorial election**:

"Scott Walker knows he's in trouble on Foxconn and he's scrambling to play defense. The public is deeply skeptical of Walker's \$4.5 billion Foxconn giveaway. Now, Walker is trying to buy his way out of a bad deal with slick TV ads. But the truth is, a few TV spots can't make up for 8 years of neglecting Wisconsin's priorities.
