

WisDems: Vukmir and Nicholson support increasing health care costs, cutting coverage

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MADISON — Leah Vukmir and Kevin Nicholson just recommitted to Washington Republicans' health care market sabotage that's spiking premiums across the country — because they're both running to work for powerful special interests in Washington, not Wisconsin families.
