WISGOP calls for immediate investigation into Palzewicz's illegal behavior

[Madison, WI] — Yesterday, it was reported on the *Mark Belling Show* that Democrat candidate for the Fifth Congressional District Tom Palzewicz was reported to the Milwaukee County Board of Ethics for a blatant violation of the law.
