[Madison, WI] — Today, the Republican Party of Wisconsin is filing a legal complaint with the Wisconsin Ethics Commission asking they investigate reports and emails that show that Tom Palzewicz, Democrat candidate in the Fifth Congressional District, used a contract through Milwaukee County government to solicit support of government workers for his campaign.
