Judge Screnock's Wisconsin Values vs. Dallet's Double Talk

Judge Michael Screnock is the clear choice for Wisconsin Supreme Court Justice [Madison, WI] — On Friday, Judge Screnock and liberal activist Rebecca Dallet faced off at the final debate in the race for Wisconsin Supreme Court Justice. Voters were left with a clear choice: Judge Michael Screnock who promised to uphold the rule of law and defend our Constitution, versus Dallet who offered voters nothing but double talk.

“Judge Dallet has contradicted herself time and again during this race, proving that voters shouldn't trust her to serve on our state's highest court,” said Alec Zimmerman, spokesman for the Republican Party of Wisconsin. “Wisconsin needs a justice like Judge Michael Screnock who will stand up for our values and defend our Constitution.”

Double Talk Dallet has contradicted herself at every turn of this campaign:

- Dallet says she is tough on crime, but she gave a man guilty of [attempted sexual assault](#) of a child a 2-year sentence instead of the maximum 20 years – the same man was [arrested again last week](#) as a “non-compliant” sex offender.
- Dallet says she'll stand for Wisconsin values, but told a room full of [San Francisco donors](#) that Wisconsin “lost” its values.

- Dallet claims she recuses herself from conflicts of interest, but she's been using her [court calendar to raise campaign cash](#). She has taken donations from attorneys who have had more than 100 cases before her court – sometimes taking donations from them within days or weeks of making major decisions on their cases.
