Hayward, WI - Liberal Seventh District Congressional candidates Margaret Engebretson, Brian Ewert, and Kyle Frenette stumbled out of the gate in the first quarter of 2018. Wisconsin Seventh District GOP Chairman Jim Miller released the following statement on their lackluster fundraising reports:

"It's clear these liberal, progressive Democrats and their campaigns are off to weak starts. Their inability to raise money when it's 'supposedly' the best environment for in a generation for Democrats shows they are not running serious campaigns. - After touting his support to news outlets, Frenette's first-quarter statements detail Frenette misstated his contributions and his fundraising totals included \$50,000 personal loan.
- Margaret Engebretson reported only \$13,700 in contributions
