Rally in Solidarity with the Migrant Caravans

The Trump administration has once again demonstrated its underlying xenophobia with its response to the caravan of refugees moving towards United States' southern border. The administration has escalated the situation at the already turbulent border. By sending thousands of military service members to the border and using tear gas against the asylum-seekers, Trump and his administration have shown political incompetence and complete disregard for the caravanners' lives.

The Young People's Resistance Committee (YPRC) will hold a rally on December 1st in response to the current administration and in support of the caravans headed towards the US/Mexico border.
