Arlington, VA – America First Policies is waging a million-dollar campaign across the country on 28 Congressmen who likely will be the swing legislators on an impeachment vote. In Wisconsin, we are mobilizing constituents to hold their Congressmen accountable and let them know it’s time to end the witch-hunt, oppose impeachment, and get back to the work of the American people.

This effort is a part of a national campaign that includes a \$283,000 Facebook advertisement buy, \$538,000 on a series of text messages urging Americans to call their representatives, and \$250,000 on cable and broadcast television.
