Wisconsin Republicans Suddenly Interested in Democratic Proposals

MADISON — After eight years of staunchly refusing to consider Democratic proposals to protect Wisconsinites' health care, fully fund the state's classrooms and provide a long-term solution to Wisconsin's transportation crisis, Assembly Republicans have suddenly expressed support for such priorities in a letter sent to Governor Tony Evers today.
