

Evers raised \$10.6 million in 2018, finished year with \$345k in bank

Gov. Tony Evers raised nearly \$10.6 million in 2018 and finished the year with \$345,485 in the bank, according to his latest campaign finance report.

The filing shows Evers raised more than \$2 million after Oct. 23 and spent \$3.4 million between that date and Dec. 31.

Altogether, Evers spent \$10.3 million last year on his campaign for gov.

By comparison, former Gov. Scott Walker had raised \$16.1 million by Oct. 22 and spent \$18.7 million. His latest campaign finance reported hadn't been posted to the state's website by late evening Tuesday.
