

Fitzgerald campaign: Announces Thompson endorsement for fifth congressional bid

[Juneau, WI] — Wisconsin Senate Majority Leader Scott Fitzgerald today announced the next in a series of prominent endorsements for his candidacy for Wisconsin's Fifth Congressional District.
