

Former gov candidate Gronik looking for best avenue to keep pushing issues

Businessman Andy Gronik, who dropped out of the gov's race nearly a year ago, said he's still looking to push some of what he advocated during his campaign.

He's just looking for the best avenue to do it.

Gronik created Stage W as an issues group and eventually launched his bid for gov. He then dropped out in June 2018, a little less than two months before the primary.

Gronik said he still wants to advocate on issues such as workforce development and education, both of which he focused on with Stage G.
