

Protect Our Care: Trump's lawsuit to overturn health care-eliminating Medicaid expansion

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MILWAUKEE, WI – In four days, Trump' Administration lawyers will go to court to overturn our health care laws. If Trump gets his way:

MEDICAID EXPANSION WOULD BE ELIMINATED

- Seventeen Million People [Enrolled Through Medicaid Expansion](#) Could Lose Coverage.
- Access To Treatment Would Be In Jeopardy For 800,000 People With Opioid Use Disorder. Roughly four in ten, or 800,000 people with an opioid use disorder [are enrolled in Medicaid](#). Many became eligible through Medicaid expansion.
- Key Support For Rural Hospitals Would Disappear, leaving hospitals with [\\$9.6](#)

billion more in uncompensated care.
