MADISON – Representative Barbara Dittrich (R-Oconomowoc) was sworn in as the state representative for Wisconsin’s 38th Assembly District this afternoon as the state Assembly convened to begin its 104th session. Dittrich comes from the non-profit sector, having served as the Executive Director and later the Director of Advancement for a non-profit serving the parents of children with disabilities and chronic illnesses. She lives in Oconomowoc with her husband, Steve, and their three children.

“As a lifelong resident of southeast Wisconsin, it is truly an honor to be representing the goals and interests of the 38th Assembly District,” said Rep.
