MADISON – The following is a statement from State Representative Tip McGuire on the partial veto of the state budget by Gov. Evers:

“I support many of the changes that Governor Evers made to the state budget, particularly the nearly \$100 million additional investment in our education system, showing yet again our deep commitment to Wisconsin students and teachers. The governor signed this budget today with the understanding that we are still far from where we need to be, and there is more work for us to do.
