

# Republican State Leadership Committee: Judicial Fairness Initiative enters Wisconsin Supreme Court Race - “When conservatives stand together, we win”

WASHINGTON, D.C. (March 26, 2019) - The Republican State Leadership Committee's Judicial Fairness Initiative (RSLC - JFI) launched its first television ad today in support of Judge Brian Hagedorn. Additional advertising will soon follow in rotation, as part of a seven figure, statewide buy that includes digital, mail, broadcast, cable and radio.

“Since losing at the ballot box at record levels over the past decade, liberal socialists led by Barack Obama and Eric Holder have turned to partisan courts in multiple states to undermine election outcomes and rig the system for Democrats,” said Matt Walter, President of the Republican State Leadership Committee. “In states like Pennsylvania, liberals actively campaigned to win seats on a partisan state Supreme Court which, in turn, undermined the state legislature’s legally-drawn Congressional map. Wisconsin’s Supreme Court is the next target for the Obama-Holder hit squad to takeover and undo the great work Wisconsin Republicans have accomplished, and elections Democrats failed to win,” added Walter.

Court watchers agree that a loss for conservatives on April 2<sup>nd</sup>, coupled with

Wisconsin's next Supreme Court election set for the same day as the Democrat Presidential Primary could enable judicial activist liberals to use Wisconsin's Supreme Court to undermine the authority of the state legislature on a variety of issues.

"Outside progressive special interest groups, bankrolled by liberal billionaires like George Soros and Tom Steyer, have already injected their anti-business, anti-capitalism message throughout Wisconsin, and now it is time conservatives swing back. When we stand together, we win," concluded Walter.
