MADISON- Today elected officials and community leaders celebrate Highway WIS 23's expansion with a groundbreaking ceremony at Wade House Historic Site. Starting this month construction will begin on the 19-mile stretch of WIS 23 - US 151 in Fond du Lac and Sheboygan counties. Senator Dan Feyen (R-Fond du Lac) released the following statement:
