MADISON- Today the Joint Committee on Finance approved a motion for an additional \$3 million in funding per year for Career and Technical Education grants (CTE grants). Senator Dan Feyen (R-Fond du Lac) fully supports this budget motion that would provide a total of \$6.5 million a year for CTE grants.
