Madison – State Senator Dan Feyen (R – Fond du Lac) released the following statement on Governor Evers’ State of the State address:

“Over the past eight years, prudent choices and fiscal discipline have put Wisconsin on the right track, creating a stable economic environment for private sector growth and providing ordinary families much needed tax relief.

With the lowest tax burden in five decades, our state is expected to generate an additional \$2.1 billion in tax revenues over the next two years. Our unemployment rate has been at or below three percent for eleven straight months. It is clear that our state is on a prosperous path.
