MADISON – Representative Tod Ohnstad (D-Kenosha) applauds Governor Evers on his announced plan to close the dark store loophole in the 2019-2020 biennial budget. “For too long, hard working Wisconsinites and local officials have been denied the ability to assess taxes in a way that is fair to everyone, not just wealthy corporations.
