**MADISON** – State Representative Paul Tittl (R-Manitowoc) is pleased to announce the release of his legislative survey. Residents throughout the 25<sup>th</sup> District should watch for it in the mail.

“People can respond to the survey by mail or go to my website at <http://legis.wisconsin.gov/assembly/25/tittl/2019-spring-survey> and complete it online,” said Rep. Tittl. “We have tried to make it as easy as possible for everyone to respond.”

The survey is not long and takes only a few minutes to complete. It asks ten questions about various topics including the state budget, raising taxes, medical marijuana, gun ownership and more. Respondents can check boxes indicating their views and provide additional comments if they desire. They must also include their name, address and phone number.

“Surveys are an important part of the legislative process,” said Rep Tittl. “They enable people to make their voice heard without having to drive to Madison to do so.”

Those who do not receive a survey and do not have computer access can phone Rep. Tittl’s Madison office and request a copy. The toll free number is 888-529-0025.

“I always welcome input, and I am looking forward to hearing what people have to

say,” said Tittl. “The best ideas often come from people in the community rather than a bunch of legislators sitting in Madison.”

This is the fourth survey Rep. Tittl has done since taking office in 2013.
