Madison...Speaker Robin Vos (R-Rochester) released the following statement after Governor Evers vetoed [Assembly Bill 249](#), which was approved by both chambers on a voice vote. The bill co-authored by Speaker Vos and Representative Dave Considine (D-Baraboo) set forth criteria for honorary highway and bridge designations.
