Today, Robert Mueller testified in the House Intelligence and Judiciary Committee to address questions about the Russia investigation and the Mueller report.

Congresswoman Moore released the following statement:

“Five Trump campaign officials have been charged with crimes. Trump and his campaign facilitated and welcomed election interference from Russia, including sharing polling data. We cannot understate the ongoing threat to our democracy. Mueller’s testimony reaffirmed that Trump is not exonerated.
