

# U.S. Rep. Steil: Campaign raises over \$360,000 in Q1

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**JANESVILLE, Wis.** – Today, Congressman Bryan Steil’s campaign announced it raised over \$360,000 in the first quarter of 2019 showing broad based support from workers across Southeast Wisconsin.

Steil’s support is a snapshot of Wisconsin’s First Congressional District. The \$364,928 raised in the first quarter of the year includes contributions from trade associations, organized labor and employee-friendly Wisconsin businesses.
