**WASHINGTON, D.C.**—Bryan Steil supported two bipartisan bills to enhance transparency within the federal government: H.R. 1654, the *Federal Register Modernization Act* and H.R. 1582, the *Electronic Message Preservation Act*.

“Citizens deserve to know what their federal government is doing and how it is spending their tax dollars. Wisconsin does a great job of holding the government accountable and being open to state taxpayers.
