

WisDOJ: AG Kaul opens public comment period for request for an attorney general opinion on agency rulemaking authority

MADISON, Wis. – Attorney General Josh Kaul today, following the posting of a request for an Attorney General (AG) opinion, is notifying the public that the public comment period for the issues raised in the request is open. The AG opinion request can be found [here](#). The public comment period will be open for 30 days.

In July 2019, Attorney General Josh Kaul unveiled a new process and website that allows the public to provide information and perspectives on proposed AG opinion topics to the Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ) prior to the issuance of AG opinions. At www.doj.state.wi.us/opinionrequests, anyone has the opportunity to weigh in on issues that will be address in AG opinions, making the process more transparent and open to input from the public.
