Motorists urged to plan ahead as backups and delays are anticipated in the area.

Westbound US 14/Humes Road near Interstate 39/90 in Janesville will be reduced to one lane from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. tomorrow (April 18). Significant backups and delays are expected as storm sewer activities are underway in the area. Motorists are urged to plan ahead, allow extra time to reach their destination, and eliminate distractions when driving.

This lane restriction and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
