After a one-day closure due to extreme weather, Wisconsin Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Customer Service Centers will reopen on Thursday, January 31 for normal business hours.

The website provides all the information needed regarding DMV service centers – including hours and services offered, a map, the address, estimated miles from the customer's location, along with directions and, at larger offices, provides current wait times.

- Change your address in DMV records.
- Order replacement driver licenses or ID cards.
- Renew your vehicle registration.
