Finalists were selected because they demonstrated excellence in one or more of the following categories: Public Policy; Political Engagement; Membership and Development; Organizational Development; Best Communications Program; and Membership Services.

The State Chamber of the Year Award has been presented to a top-performing state chamber since 2016.
