MADISON, WI- Americans for Prosperity-Wisconsin (AFP-WI) today issued a statement regarding the Wisconsin Supreme Court's ruling in the legislature's lawsuit.

AFP-WI State Director Eric Bott issued the following statement:

"The Wisconsin Supreme Court's ruling in this case is a win for the protection of the separation of powers and the necessary legislative and public oversight in the administrative rule-making process.

"As AFP-WI stated in our Amicus Curiae brief, there are commonsense ways people can work together to develop an approach that both protects health and keeps food on the table for Wisconsin families.
