Lynn Murphy, wife of 56th Assembly District Representative Dave Murphy (R-Greenville), formally endorsed Cabral-Guevara.

Her role at UW-Oshkosh includes instructing more than 90 students in both classroom, clinical, and labs in clinical nursing.

Cabral-Guevara lives in Neenah and is mother of four. She is a Neenah Rotary member, volunteer at Alliance Elementary School, and has provided lectures for the National Alliance for Mentally Ill.
