The small businesswoman, Nurse Practitioner, and senior lecturer said the level of support she received while circulating nomination papers was both inspirational and heartwarming.

high deductibles or no insurance. NPHS provides house calls, nursing services, labs, X-ray, and a full services clinic in Appleton. She earned a Masters in Science Nursing from UW-Milwaukee and a Bachelors of Science in Nursing from UW-Oshkosh. In addition, Cabral Guevara has served as a senior lecturer at UW-Oshkosh for more than a decade. Her role at UW-Oshkosh includes instructing more than 96 students in both classroom and clinical on clinical nursing each semester.
