[NEENAH, WI...] The Rachael for Assembly campaign today announced the endorsement of Debbie Rohrkaste, wife of current 55th Assembly District Representative Mike Rohrkaste (R-Neenah), in the Republican primary race.

Cabral-Guevara lives in Neenah and is mother of four. She is a Neenah Rotary member, volunteer at Alliance Elementary School, and has provided lectures for the National Alliance for Mentally Ill.
