MILWAUKEE – Today, State Representative JoCasta Zamarripa announced her endorsement of David Crowley to be the next Milwaukee County Executive.

He is the Chair of the Milwaukee Delegation, the Chair of the Black Caucus, and the Co-Chair of the Black and Latino Caucus.
