MADISON, Wis. — The Dairy Business Association, Wisconsin's leading dairy lobbying group, issued a statement today regarding the outcome of the state's legislative races in Tuesday's election.

In the state Legislature, Republicans maintained control with a new 20-13 majority in the Senate, an increase of two seats, and a 61-38 majority in the Assembly, a decrease of two.
