

Democratic Governors Association: Gov. Evers denounces Wisconsin Supreme Court's decision to throw state into chaos

Last night on CNN, Democratic Wisconsin Gov. Tony Evers denounced the [state Supreme Court's decision to strike down his stay at home order](#). The ruling immediately ended Gov. Evers' requirements for residents to stay "[safer at home,](#)" [resulting in crowds of people descending into bars and restaurants.](#)

Gov. Evers said: "Today, absolutely, Wisconsin Republican legislators and those four Supreme Court justices decided that facts don't matter, statutes don't matter, and frankly, it puts our state into chaos."

The harmful [lawsuit from Wisconsin Republican legislators](#) is out of line with public opinion in the state. A recent Marquette University poll showed [69%](#) of Wisconsin voters support Evers' stay at home order, including nearly half of GOP voters. If businesses reopen without social distancing measures and residents venture out [against the advice of public health officials](#), Gov. Evers warned there could be unnecessary deaths.
