

# Dept. of Transportation: I-39/90 southbound reduced to one lane today (May 20) in Janesville

I-39/90 southbound will be restricted to one lane from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. today (May 20) near the WIS 26/Milton Avenue interchange (Exit 171A) in Janesville. A 14-foot width restriction will occur within the work zone, and oversize vehicles must use the interchange ramps to bypass the operation. Construction crews will complete repairs to the existing southbound Interstate bridge over the highway.

Slowdowns may occur on I-39/90 southbound in this area. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, use alternate routes and allow extra time to safely reach their destination.
