

Dept. of Transportation: Mad City Sales dealer license suspended 45 days

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) on March 26, 2020 suspended the motor vehicle dealership license of Mad City Sales, Inc., Madison.
