

# Gov. Evers: More than 200 organizations, businesses, elected officials, and medical professionals support safer at home efforts

MADISON — On April 23, 2020, more than 200 businesses, city, county, and tribal government officials, medical professionals, and organizations representing everything from labor and educators to religious entities, to civil rights, to veterans affairs, signed a letter of support for Wisconsin's Safer at Home efforts.
