MADISON — Gov. Tony Evers announced today that he is seeking applicants for appointment as register of deeds in Eau Claire County.

The appointment will fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Kathryn Christenson, effective Feb. 7, 2020. The new register of deeds will complete a term ending Jan. 3, 2021.

Interested applicants must submit an online application with a cover letter detailing professional and academic qualifications, civic activities, and community involvement. **Application materials must be received no later than 5 p.m. on Fri., Jan. 17, 2020.**
