

Kelly continues to outraise Supreme Court rivals

Conservative Justice Daniel Kelly pulled in \$187,463 during the pre-primary period as he continued to build a healthy financial advantage over his Supreme Court rivals.

Kelly spent \$297,567 between Jan. 1 and Feb. 3, finishing the period with \$462,864 in the bank.

Dane County Judge Jill Karofsky raised \$65,354, spent \$163,235 and had \$83,393 cash on hand.

Meanwhile, Marquette University Law School Prof. Ed Fallon raised \$22,047, spent \$7,555 and had \$51,904 in the bank.
